

# Computer Blizzard Bag

**NOTE:** All of the following lessons require internet access and a computer with a keyboard, either a laptop or a PC. If you do not have access to either, please email me at [ntosi@saintraphaelparish.com](mailto:ntosi@saintraphaelparish.com) and I will provide a different lesson. Also, you only have to do the lesson if you are missing the day that you would normally be in class. The class schedule for each grade is provided below.

**Kindergarten** - Go onto [abcya.com](http://abcya.com). Click on "Grade 2" then on the purple "skill" section. The student should then select "Keyboard Challenge." Complete the keyboard puzzle twice on all keys. The class is 45 minutes long. If finished with "Keyboard Challenge" prior to 45 minutes, then choose another educational game on [abcya.com](http://abcya.com). The kindergarten computer schedule is as follows:

**First and Second Grade** - Log into [edutyping.com](http://edutyping.com) and type for two separate sessions of 22 minutes. Do not try to do all at once as it is too long to sit and type. Below is the following schedule:

Username: the username is the graduation year plus your first initial of your first name and your entire last name. Graduation year for 1st grade is 27 and for 2nd grade 26. So, for example, 26ntosi for second grade and 27ntosi for first. No spaces and no capital letters
