

Children's Eucharistic Adoration

2018 – 2019 Every Friday

Should my child go to Children's Adoration? Yes! Short periods before the Blessed Sacrament are a great introduction to a child's understanding the Real Presence of Jesus in the Eucharist. It also brings great peace, mental clarity, and reinforces the practice of "going" to Jesus outside of Mass.

I don't really have time.

That's OK. We will lead your child to the chapel for 20 minutes of engaging, joyful, guided adoration.

What will the children do in Adoration?

Each Friday after SRS dismissal, we will lead your child in prayer and song, and sometimes do activities that relate to current feast or holy days in the Liturgical Calendar. We pray the Act of Contrition, ask our Lord for things in Petition, and sing prayers of Thanksgiving. (And eat a snack afterward!)



Our focus will be "Our ACTS Matter"
(Adore, Confess, Thanksgiving, and Supplication/Petitions).

How does my child join in Adoration?

Every Friday at SRS dismissal, both Day School and PSR children are invited to meet and process from Good Shepherd Square to the Chapel, led by an adult, at **3:30pm** beginning in September, through April. You can pick your child up in the Adoration Chapel at **4:00pm** or at Good Shepherd Square (lobby of the school) at **4:05pm**, where they enjoy a snack.

When is Children's Adoration?

We will start Children's Adoration this year on Friday, **September 7th, 2018 at 3:30pm** and meet Every Friday through **April 26th, 2019, EXCEPT those Fridays that SRS Day School is closed.**
