Tuition Assistance

St. Raphael School partners with FACTS Tuition Management Company to manage our tuition assistance assessment. Tuition assistance is available to parishioners from both the Diocese of Cleveland and St. Raphael Parish. Families applying for tuition assistance should apply to both the Diocese of Cleveland and St. Raphael Parish. The application and all required supporting documentation (2020 tax return) are submitted directly on-line to FACTS. A \$35 fee is due. The same application is used for both the Diocese and the parish. All information submitted is confidential. FACTS will review the application and calculate an amount eligible for tuition assistance. Families will be responsible for paying a minimum of \$500.00 per student regardless of the FACTS calculated need. Please note: Registration and Technology fees are not eligible for financial assistance and must be paid by the family.

NOTE: For applications received or completed after June 15th families will be responsible for paying a minimum of \$1,000.00 per student regardless of the FACTS calculated need.
