We are pleased to tell you that we will be using a website called IXL in place of Summer Simple Solutions this year. IXL is a comprehensive learning program offering unlimited math and language arts practice across thousands of skills—all of which are aligned to Ohio Standards. **Your child's participation in the math portion of this program over the summer is mandatory.**

To get your child started on your home computer, please follow these easy steps:

1. Go to <https://www.ixl.com>
2. Enter your child's username and password and click "Sign in."
(Note: **DO NOT misplace this login information.**)

3. Click on Math and your child's **CURRENT GRADE** (**not** the grade they will be entering in the fall).
4. Your child is responsible for completing the practice skills that are ***starred/highlighted** (mandatory summer skills will be starred/highlighted as of June 5th).
5. Students must earn a **Smart Score of 80** in each skill area to consider that skill completed. We have included a chart to color in the skill boxes to help your child keep track of completion.
6. Next year's teachers will be checking for completion the first week of school. Students are only responsible for completing the starred/highlighted skills, but are welcome to continue to practice with additional skills as desired.
7. **PLEASE LOGIN BEFORE THE LAST DAY OF SCHOOL IN CASE OF QUESTIONS.**
Teachers will not be available over the summer, so if further questions arise, you will need to contact IXL after June 5th.

Students should login a few times per week to complete practice spread-out over the summer. All of your child's results will be saved. For on-the-go practice, you can download IXL's free tablet apps for iPad, Android, or Kindle and sign in with your child's username and password.
