Dear Parents,

The Finance Council has approved the tuition for the 2021-2022 school year. The tuition is increasing \$175.00 per student. The annual cost to educate a student in the day school is approximately \$5,600 at current enrollment levels; tuition & fees cover about 75% of the cost. The Parish covers the substantial financial difference between per pupil cost and the actual tuition through state funding, its weekly offertory collection, and the generosity of those associated with the Parish.

The annual Education Fee and Technology Fee per student are non-refundable and are payable at registration. These fees are in addition to and not included in the tuition. No child will be considered registered unless and until both the Education and Technology fees are paid.
