Students will be asked to use the restrooms and wash hands before they arrive for their lunch period.

Students will be dismissed directly from the lunchroom to recess. They will bring their coats to lunch. Students will not be permitted to return to their classrooms after eating. Lunchboxes will be collected in the lunchroom and then returned to the classrooms. Alcohol-free hand sanitizers are located in the lunchroom for student use.

Students who have peanut allergies will sit at an "Allergy Free Table" to ensure their safety and health. They will be encouraged to invite friends to sit with them as long as their friends' lunches do not contain any peanut products. We are asking for everyone's cooperation by not sending in food that contains peanuts or peanut butter if the child is going to sit at the "Allergy Free Table."
